### Requirements:

- A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher with at least 12 credits completed at Pitt-Greensburg.
- Can be a commuter student or a resident student.
- Enrolled as a full-time student during Fall 2024 semester.
- Under no current student conduct, administrative, or academic sanctions.
- Preference given to those who have completed Cornerstone or Transfer/First-Year Seminar course.

### Remuneration:

- Earn up to 3 academic directed-study credits for the 2024-2024 academic year as approved by academic affairs.
- Training on various topics of personal and professional development.
- Enhanced communication skills.
- Connections to faculty, staff, and other students while helping others.

### Responsibilities:

- Attend training sessions, including a day of training on Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024 (for SOAR) and training on August 19 and 20, 2024 (for Cornerstone/Seminar).
- Participate in summer 2024 Summer Orientation sessions and reside on campus from Wednesday evening until Friday afternoon on the following dates: June 26-28, July 10-12, and July 24-26, 2023. (Some flexibility for special circumstances.)
- Participate in 2024 Welcome Week activities from Wednesday, August 21 through Sunday, August 25, 2023.
- Fulfill the following Cornerstone/Seminar responsibilities for the Fall 2024 semester (with an opportunity to continue in the spring 2025 semester):
  1. Attend and actively participate in assigned class every week.
  2. Meet with instructor once a week.
  3. Assist the instructor as needed with early alert monitoring, class syllabus, classroom activities and discussions, and evaluation of assignments.
  4. Facilitate at least one class on the topic of your choice (or study sessions, in certain sections) with assistance from the instructor.
  5. Organize and/or attend out-of-class activities with the students.
  6. Coordinate and implement one class community service project.
  7. Meet at least once individually with each student outside of class and maintain on-going communications with the students in the class throughout the semester.
- Attend bi-weekly staff meetings run by the Assistant Director of the First-Year Experience with the other peer leaders during the Fall 2024 semester.

### Selection Process:

- Candidates must submit a completed online application and two recommendation forms from professional references. **Applications are due by Friday, March 22, 2024.**
- Qualified candidates will **interview** with Haley Hayden, Asst. Dir. of the First-Year Experience.
